NOTES

1. A Transfer is required if, having played a match in either the SEPL or the HCL in the current season, a *player wishes to play for a different club in the same season.*
2. The player is responsible for sending the completed form to the Secretary of the League in which he now wishes to play. (If this is in doubt, because the new team has a team in more than one league, to the Secretary of the Senior League concerned).
3. The transfer will not be approved unless Sections 1, 2 and 3 are completed and signed.
4. If the present clubs objects to the transfer and refuses to complete Section 2, reasons must be stated separately. Normally the only reasonable objection is that the player has significant unpaid debts or other unfulfilled obligations.
5. If there are objections, the League Secretary will inform both clubs whether the objection is accepted or overruled.
6. The League Secretary will inform the new club, by telephone, when the player is eligible to play in a League match.
7. The League Secretary will copy the completed transfer form to the other Leagues concerned, if appropriate.
